- 3. By June 30th, submit completed Application and all supporting documentation to RTSC, PO Box 5996, Vallejo, CA 94591.

Qualifications Required:

- One or more household members must qualify as one of the following:
 - Senior (65 years or older)
 - Disabled
 - Military (Active, honorably discharged, retired or a surviving spouse)
- Own and live in a single family residence located within northern Solano County (Fairfield / Vacaville / Suisun City / Suisun). Home to be stick-built;
- The following items must be paid current: 1) Mortgage(s) 2) Property Taxes 3) Homeowner's Insurance;
- Potential homeowners cannot own other property or units unless located on the property of the primary residence;
- Meet low-income guidelines for Solano County (less than 80% of Area Median Income for 2016/2017)
