## 2013 Projects:

- On January 21, 2013, MLK Holiday (and in March, 2013) rehabilitation work was completed at the Vallejo Mare Island Museum in collaborative with sponsors, <u>Kaiser Permanente</u>, <u>Kelly Moore Paints</u>, and <u>Recology Vallejo</u>. More than 250 community volunteers (including 47 Kaiser employees) and local businesses donating their materials and services participated in our workday. Completed work was valued at more than \$50,000 with approximately \$5,000 in expenses.
- The Travis Air Museum Workday was held on MLK 2013 in collaborative with sponsors, <u>Kaiser Permanente</u>, and <u>Kelly Moore Paints</u>. More than 40 community volunteers (including 18 Kaiser employees) and local businesses donating their materials and services participated in our workday. Completed work was valued at more than \$15,000 with approximately \$3,000 in expenses.
- Vacaville MLK 2013 Workday was completed at the Center for Imaginative Reuse to turn this city facility from a greyhound bus terminal to a nonprofit organization. More than 45 workday volunteers (including 12 Kaiser employees) worked on rehabilitating this facility due to the generous support of our corporate sponsor, <u>Kaiser Permanente</u>. Volunteers worked tirelessly cleaned, painted, as well as yard work. Completed work was valued at more than \$40,000 with approximately \$4,000 in expenses.
- In March/ April, 2013, the Rio Vista Community / Senior Center had extensive interior work completed by volunteers. This included concrete floor repair, installation of tile flooring, debris removal, drywall replacement, electrical assessment / repairs, cleaning, painting, mold and asbestos remediation, installation of ADA toilets / grab bars, construction of new storage cabinets

and landscaping. Funds for this project were donated by <u>The City of Rio Vista</u>, <u>Rio Vista Citizens</u> for Seniors, <u>Rio Vista Community</u> and the <u>Rio Vista Lion's Club</u>. The volunteer labor of more than 400 individuals and the donated materials were provided various unions including <u>Bricklayers</u>, <u>Tilelayers and Allied Craftworkers Bay Area Local 3 Union</u>, <u>City of Rio Vista Public Works</u>, <u>Construction Concierge</u>, <u>Kevin P. Moran Construction</u>, <u>Randu Original Tile and Stone</u>, <u>Roofers and Weatherproofers Union Local 81</u>, <u>Shandrika's Décor</u> and <u>Solano County Roofing</u>. Completed work was valued at more than \$180,000 with approximately \$30,000 in expenses.

- In May, 2013, the <u>Carpenters Local 180 Union</u> assisted Rebuilding Together Solano County with replacement of damaged exterior siding on the south facing building wall of the Vacaville Center for Imaginative Reuse. Also, <u>Home Depot Vacaville</u> employees donated their time in May, 2013 to complete yard work and landscaping for this community facility in Vacaville, CA.
- In August, 2013, the Vallejo Boys n Girls Club received an exterior paint job as well as extensive yard work all completed by the more than 70 community volunteers. This workday was accomplished via our 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual, A Call To Change Vallejo collaborative with <u>Vallejo Outreach</u>,. Sponsors included: <u>Kelly Moore Paints</u>, <u>Recology Vallejo</u>, <u>Valero</u>, and <u>Vallejo Soroptimists</u>. Work completed with a value of more than \$50,000 with less than \$5,000 in expenses.
- In August / September, 2013, three military homeowners received necessary health and safety repairs at their own home. This included 2 homes in Vallejo, CA and one home in Fairfield, CA. Sponsorship was provided by: <u>Bank of the West, Construction Concierge Fairfield Host Lion's Club, First Bank, Home Depot Foundation, Home Depot At Home Services, Kelly Moore Paints, M and M Sanitary LLC, Randu Original Tile and Stone, Recology Vallejo, Umpqua Bank, and Vallejo Rotary Club. Each home received repairs totaling more than \$50,000 with less than \$5,000 in expenses.</u>
- On September 11<sup>th</sup>, Rebuilding Together volunteers (along with volunteers from Wells Fargo, Travis AFB and Vallejo Veterans) provided necessary health and safety repairs on the exterior of the home due to sponsorship from <u>Wells Fargo</u>. In total, more than 75 volunteers worked tirelessly to build more than 80 feet of new fence, paint the exterior of the home, haul debris, build 2 new gates, install basement crawl vents, install new garage side door for security and extensive yard work.
- In October, 2013, one additional military homeowner in Fairfield received necessary health and safety repairs on the exterior of the home due to sponsorship from <u>Bank of the West</u> and <u>Fairfield Host Lion's Club</u>. In total, more than 25 volunteers (including 20 Travis AFB volunteers) worked tirelessly to build more than 180 feet of new fence, paint the exterior of the home, build 2 new gates, install basement crawl vents and yard work.
- In October, 2013 <u>Home Depot At Home Services</u>, <u>Home Depot Vallejo</u> and <u>Recology Vallejo</u> partnered to provide a widow of a veteran in Vallejo, CA with a new roof, gutters and house insulation.
- In November, 2013, an additional military homeowner received necessary health and safety repairs
  at their Vallejo home. The <u>IBEW (Electricans Union)</u> re-wired the entire home, a new heater was
  installed compliments of <u>Miller Signs and Sheet Metal Company</u> along with additional rehab
  provided by <u>Doug Kahley Memorial Project</u>, <u>Home Depot Foundation</u>, <u>Kelly Moore Paints</u>, <u>M and M</u>
  Sanitary LLC, Randu Original Tile and Stone, and Recology Vallejo.
- In November, 2013 a military homeowner in Vacaville received necessary health and safety repairs
  on the exterior of the home due to sponsorship from <a href="The Home Depot Foundation">The Home Depot Foundation</a>, Home Depot
