## How to apply:

1. Complete 2017-2018 Homeowner Application
2. By March 31st, mail the completed Application and all supporting documentation to RTSC, PO Box 5996, Vallejo, CA 94591. Your application must be postmarked no later than 3/31/18.

## Qualifications Required:

- One or more household members must qualify as one of the following:
  - Military (Active, honorably discharged, retired or a surviving spouse)
  - Senior (65 years or older)
  - Disabled
- Own and live in a single family residence located within Solano County. Home to be stick-built;
- The following items must be paid current: 1) Mortgage(s) 2) Property Taxes 3) Homeowner's Insurance;
- Potential homeowners cannot own other property or units unless located on the property of the primary residence;
- Meet low-income guidelines for Solano County (less than 80% of Area Median Income for 2017-2018)

We are excited that Rebuilding Together has provided services in Solano County since June, 2009.
