RTSC is a nonprofit organization that repairs and renovates homes for low-income veterans / seniors and community facilities in Solano County with the partnership of local companies, businesses and service organizations. Our goal is to provide a safe and healthy environment for low-income senior homeowners and residents receiving services in our community facilities.

Rebuilding Together has provided services in Solano County since June, 2009. With more than 4,750 volunteers, RTSC has provided necessary home repairs for 34 low-income seniors (one living in Vacaville, five residing in Fairfield/Suisun City, two living in Benicia and twenty-two residing in Vallejo). Also, RTSC has held more than forty-four community facility workdays in Benicia, Fairfield, Rio Vista, Suisun City, Vacaville and Vallejo. For every dollar invested in a RTSC project, our return to the low-income homeowner and neighborhood has been six-fold. In total, Rebuilding Together has invested more than \$5,000,000 into revitalizing low-income homes, community facilities and neighborhoods in Solano County.

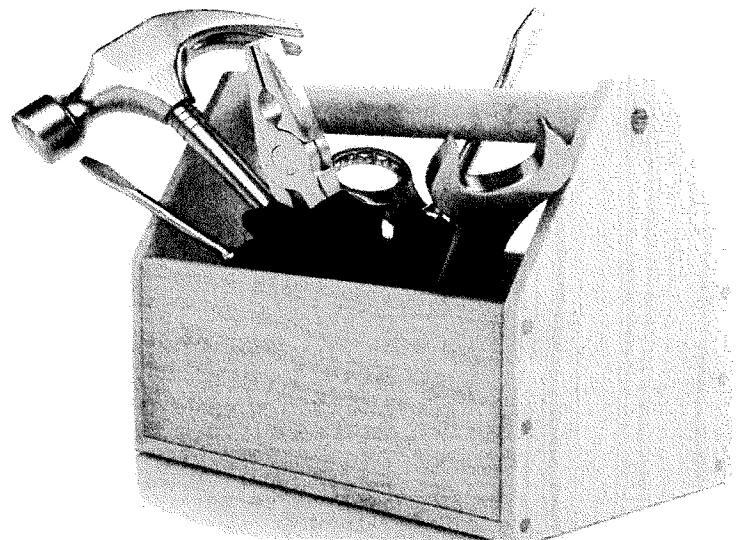

During a project, local businesses, community members and concerned residents come together from all walks of life to rehabilitate homes and community facilities in Solano County. This is accomplished with volunteer labor—both skilled and unskilled—donated materials/services and financial support from within the county. Since June, 2009, Rebuilding Together has rehabilitated 32 homes for low-income homeowners (disabled / seniors / military) and held more than 42 community facility workdays in Solano County. Total value of rehab work donated by RTSC and our volunteers exceeds \$4.75 million.

## MISSION

As a housing nonprofit organization, we assist low-income homeowners with home rehabilitation projects - focusing on providing a healthy and safe home. Our focus is low-income seniors, disabled individuals and veterans. In addition to home rehabilitation, Rebuilding Together also assists community facilities with needed repairs. During a project, local businesses, community members and concerned residents come together from all walks of life to rehabilitate homes in Solano County. This is accomplished with volunteer skilled and unskilled labor, donated materials/services and financial support from within Solano County.

## SOLANO COUNTY IMPACT

From June, 2009 thru December, 2016, more than 4,500 Rebuilding Together volunteers have rehabilitated **30** homes for low-income homeowners (seniors / military / disabled) and held more than **40** community facility workdays in Solano County, CA. In addition, Rebuilding Together has installed more than 860 smoke and 145 carbon monoxide alarms benefitting 330 mobile home residents. **Estimated value of work is more than \$4,500,000.**
