Rebuilding Together Solano County (RTSC) is a local nonprofit organization dedicated to allowing low-income veterans, seniors and disabled residents the ability to remain in their home – safely and with dignity. Our mission is to repair homes, revitalize communities and rebuild lives.

Since April 2018, Rebuilding Together Solano County (RTSC) has offered a weekly food pantry to veterans, seniors and disabled residents via the Feeding America Program of the Solano / Contra Costa Food Bank. Due to COVID-19, RTSC has expanded our food pantry from 250 households a month to more than 1,000. Also, the amount of food distributed on a weekly basis has increased from 750 lbs to more than 9,000 lbs per week.

RTSC is pleased to announce the addition of a monthly food giveaway dedicated to veterans, active military and other military families in Solano County.
