Rebuilding Together Solano County (RTSC) is a local nonprofit organization dedicated to allowing low-income veterans, seniors and disabled residents the ability to remain in their home – safely and with dignity. Our mission is to provide safe and healthy homes, revitalize communities and rebuild lives.

Since May, 2020, RTSC has provided a Drive Thru Food Pantry to low-income veteran / senior / disabled families in Solano County as well as 14 mobile sites including low-income mobile home parks throughout Solano County, a low-income elementary school and disabled organizations. RTSC has distributed more than 500,000 lbs. of food to in the past year as part of Feeding America / Food Bank of Solano Contra Costa County. This program has provided more than 3,000 households a month with the opportunity to solve their food insecurity.
