RTSC is a local nonprofit organization dedicated to allowing low-income veteran, senior and disabled residents the ability to remain in their home – safely and with dignity. Our mission is to provide safe and healthy homes, revitalize communities and rebuild lives.

Since May, 2020, RTSC has provided a Drive Thru Food Pantry to low-income veteran / senior / disabled families in Solano County as well as 16 mobile sites including low-income mobile home parks throughout Solano County, a low-income elementary school and organizations saving the disabled. RTSC has distributed more than 500,000 lbs. of food in the past year as part of Feeding America / Food Bank of Contra Costa / Solano Counties. Each month, RTSC has provided more than 3,500 households with the opportunity to ease their food insecurity and remain in their own home.
