In sponsorship with **WELLS FARGO** and **HOME DEPOT**, Rebuilding Together Solano County (RTSC) is pleased to announce a special distribution of Disaster Safe At Home Kits dedicated for veterans, active military, and other military families in Solano County in honor of Veterans Day 2023. In addition, RTSC will have a raffle for grocery gift cards and raised garden boxes.

RTSC is a local nonprofit organization dedicated to allowing low-income veteran, senior and disabled residents the ability to remain in their home – safely and with dignity. Our mission is to provide safe and healthy homes, revitalize communities and rebuild lives.

All veteran / military households receiving either a Disaster Safe At Home Kit are required to provide the following:

1. Driver’s License - showing Solano County address
2. Military ID / VA Card or DD-214 Discharge Documentation

NOTE: Each household is allowed only 1 Safe At Home Kit per year.

Since 2009, Rebuilding Together with more than 12,000 community volunteers have provided our home rehab services to more than 42 low-income homeowners as well as held more than 52 community facility workdays in Solano County. In partnership with local fire departments, RTSC has installed and/or donated more than 4,710 smoke and 2,885 carbon monoxide alarms in low-income mobile home parks. Also, RTSC has provided a Drive Thru Food Pantry to low-income veteran / senior / disabled families in Solano County as well as mobile sites including low-income mobile home parks throughout Solano County, a low-income elementary school and organizations serving the disabled. RTSC has distributed more than 750,000 lbs. of food in the past year as part of Feeding America via the Food Bank of Contra Costa / Solano Counties. Estimated value of work is more than \$10,000,000.
