All households receiving food are required on an annual basis to provide the following:

- 1. Intake Form
- 2. Driver's License
- 3. Utility Bill showing Solano County address

For Seniors – Drivers License showing 65 years or older For Veteran-Discharge Documentation (DD214) or Military ID For Disabled - Federal / State Proof of Disability

The maximum number of items per household is determined by RTSC on a daily basis and our program allows food pickup from 1 client per household.
