

2024 VETERAN HOME REHAB WORKDAY IN HONOR OF SEPTEMBER 11TH

Her disabled husband passed away in February 2022 after serving in the Army as a Cook during Vietnam.

RTSC is a local nonprofit organization dedicated to allowing low-income veteran, senior and disabled residents the ability to remain in their home – safely and with dignity. Our mission is to provide safe and healthy homes, revitalize communities and rebuild lives.

Some of the projects include yard work, tree trimming, pressure washing, exterior painting, fence construction, fence staining, removal of ADA Ramp, gutter cleanout, removal of outdoor shed, garage cleanout / organization, debris hauling, replacement of hot water heater, installation of grab bars / smoke alarms / CO alarm, and installation of LED motion lighting fixtures.

Since 2009, Rebuilding Together Solano County (RTSC) with more than 12,000 community volunteers have provided home rehab services to more than 42 low-income homeowners as well as held more than 52 community facility workdays in Solano County. In addition, RTSC has installed and/or donated more than 4,810 smoke and 2,900 carbon monoxide alarms in low-income mobile home parks and homes. RTSC has distributed more than 1,800 Safe at Home Kits to Solano County veterans. Also, RTSC has provided a Drive Thru Food Pantry via 12 mobile sites including low-income mobile home parks throughout Solano County, a low-income Vallejo elementary school and organizations serving the disabled. RTSC has distributed more than 500,000 lbs. of food in the past year as part of Feeding America via the Food Bank of Contra Costa / Solano Counties. Our services are provided free of charge to low-income veteran, senior and disabled residents of Solano County, CA. Estimated value of work is more than \$10,000,000.
